#### Beginning of the Year Reminders and Updates

- A wide brimmed sun hat is required throughout the term – please ensure this is in your child's bag every day and please name it clearly.
- Please clearly name all clothing including swimming gear and goggles. It is much easier to return it to its rightful owner.

#### Bikes / Scooters

All Wairoa and Waimea Team bikes and scooters are to be parked in the bike stands (at the front of the school) at the beginning of the day please. Children can access these to ride on the bike track at lunch time if they wish. Bikes and scooters are to be walked as far as the Ellis Street Autos car park at the end of the day. A teacher will be on duty to monitor this. This will help avoid some of the congestion and make things much safer for those walking. When biking an appropriate bike helmet is required.

#### Swimming

All classes are timetabled to swim every day - please ensure your child has their togs, towel and goggles with them every day. Even if the weather looks unsuitable in the morning, it is often fine and hot later in the day. Our swimming programme supports water confidence, the senior swimming sports in March and the upcoming school and Weetbix tryathlon.
